Gourmet take-out food now available in local area

Business open behind Piccadilly, only flower shop in Gassaway

For some time, the town of Gassaway lacked a full-service flower shop, but that problem no longer exists. Piccadilly, a branch of a larger floral shop located in Flatwoods, is in full operation on Elk Street in Gassaway. An interesting "backdoor neighbor" offers a different type of service: what owner and chef Harris Wolverton calls "gourmet take-out." Harris Gourmet Pick-up, tucked into a small space, offers far more than seems possible.

Chef Wolverton provides a variety of lunch items including hot dogs, meatball subs, BLT subs, and side salads. These have become popular with local workers who can call in an order, then pick it up or come into the kitchen, order it, and sit on a stool to watch it being made. The owner/chef enjoys people visiting while he prepares their food, he noted.

Dinner entrees vary from day to day and will change as the seasons change. Currently, Wolverton mentioned

the popularity of a summer salad consisting of strawberries, pecans, pineapple, dried cranberries and spring mix with feta cheese and a raspberry vinaigrette dressing. The owner also noted that he will prepare fewer "comfort foods" such as lasagna during warmer weather. To learn what's offered, individuals can go to the business Facebook page.

Wolverton prides himself on the quality of the ingredients he uses and his methods of preparation. For example, he buys local beef from Wayne Cattle Company. He also bakes his own bread/buns (except hot dog buns) and makes his own pasta, even to the point of rolling it out with a rolling pin. "I try to provide things that one doesn't normally find in Braxton County," he explained. Here he mentioned trying steak gyros, which have proved popular.

The story of his training is somewhat convoluted, he noted. He began his career in food preparation with a job at Minney's Family Restaurant at Frametown. "I

needed a job, and they gave me one," he said. "They taught me a lot." While he was there, his interest grew, and he "decided to do something about it" so he began culinary school. He enrolled into an online culinary school, "one of the Top 10 in the United States," he said. Currently he is taking additional classes to obtain an associate degree in culinary arts and operations.

Asked about his favorite part of the business, Wolverton responded, "I enjoy it all. Everything has its own reward."

And fronting all of this is Piccadilly's flower shop. Angie Wolverton, who manages the shop, explained that this branch was opened because "Gassaway needed its own downtown florist, and part of my vision was to give back to my hometown."

In addition to floral arrangements for special occasions, the florist works with local funeral homes in providing flowers and helping in other ways, Angie Wolverton emphasized. "We take calls 24-7 for funeral flowers," she said. Piccadilly's is open Monday through Saturday.

Spurgeon Friend Pleads Guilty to Burglary

Others Have Day in Circuit Court

The Honorable Richard A. Facemire recently completed several court orders in the Braxton County Circuit Court. Braxton County Prosecuting Attorney Jasmine R.H. Morton and Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Dara A. Acord represented the state in the proceedings. Mike Haley, Jacob Foster, Deandre Williams, and Tyler Morlan were also present for some of the hearings on behalf of the Braxton County Probation Office.

On May 11, Spurgeon Glen Friend appeared in court with his attorney Tyler Cottrill. Before the start of the jury trial, the defendant accepted the plea agreement offered by the state. Friend pled guilty to the felony offense of burglary. The state agreed to recommend an alternative sentence and to dismiss the other charge in the indictment.

Vincent Franklin Harris and attorney Tyler Cottrill came before Judge Facemire for a plea hearing. The defendant entered a guilty plea to the felony offense of unlawful assault. The state agreed to dismiss the indictment for voluntary manslaughter and to reserve the right to argue for incarceration at sentencing.

Judge Facemire accepted both plea agreements and set the sentencing hearings for

July 11.

On May 9, Sabrina E. Bookheimer appeared in court on a hearing for probation revocation. She was represented by Andrew Shaffer. She admitted to the allegations contained in the petition to revoke probation. After the court revoked her probation, her attorney requested she be sentenced to serve her time as she is close to completing it with the credit for time served on both home confinement and in jail. Bookheimer was sentenced to two years on the felony charge of fourth degree arson. She was given 452 days of credit against her sentence.

On May 5, Stephen Eugene Cutlip and his attorney David Karickhoff appeared before Judge Facemire for a sentencing hearing. The defense requested probation or an alternative sentence saying he had accepted responsibility for his actions. The state stood silent per the plea agreement. The court found Cutlip in need of correctional treatment and would likely reoffend if granted an alternative sentence. On the felony offense of burglary, the defendant was sentenced to one to fifteen years in prison.

Tanya Marie Conrad came to court with her attorney Jonathan Fittro for a sentencing hearing. Conrad asked the court for an

alternative sentence as she had entered an inpatient drug treatment program voluntarily. The state stayed silent per the plea agreement. The court granted her request and suspended the two to ten year sentence for possession of fentanyl with intent to deliver. Conrad is to be admitted to probation for a period of five years.

Betsy Lynn Cogar appeared in court with attorney David Karickhoff for a plea hearing. On the felony charge of possession of fentanyl with intent to deliver, she entered a guilty plea. The state, as their part of the agreement, would stand silent at sentencing and dismiss remaining charges against the defendant. The court set the sentencing hearing on June 1 after accepting the plea agreement.

On April 26, Ashlan Nicole Rogers came before Judge Facemire with her attorney Eric Wildman for a petition to revoke probation. The defendant admitted to the allegations in the petition. Therefore, the court revoked her probation. The defense requested Rogers be readmitted to probation with the state agreeing with inpatient drug treatment as a term and condition. The court ordered Rogers to serve 120 days then be readmitted to probation for a period of seven years.

Legislative Update

As I write on Sunday evening from interim legislative meetings in Morgantown, it's been quite a while since our monthly meetings have been held "on the road". It's a logistical nightmare for staff, with the need to transport computers, paperwork for meetings, and all sorts of miscellaneous items, as there's no going back to your office for a forgotten item. Legislators need only to show up, attend the meetings, and do their work.

I want to thank the entire staff of the House, Senate, and Joint Committee for their hard work and planning when the legislature meets outside the Capitol. They do a fantastic job and deserve our appreciation. Later this year, we'll be meeting in the eastern panhandle - the other area of growth outside the Morgantown area. Staff will again get to prepare for another successful legislative roadshow.

Of all the dozens of interim committees that meet during and after the session, the Joint Committee on Government and Finance is, by far, the committee that makes the decisions that most directly affect the House and Senate, both before, during and after each session. It's a small group - seven each from the House and Senate - and a fraction of the total 134 members of the Legislature. Few members have the opportunity to

serve on Joint Committee and I've had the opportunity to do so for more than half of my twenty-six-year tenure.

Earlier today, we met at the WVU Erickson Alumni Center to discuss what reports the Joint Committee receive monthly from every department and agency for review, now and into the future. If you want to know the nuts and bolts of how state government works, these monthly 200-page reports offer insights not otherwise available in a timely manner and then, not without massive research.

The monthly report is about to become much larger. While this may seem unimportant to many, the new reports to be added are very relevant to your tax dollars, access to broadband, infrastructure, and multiple other functions of state government. Under discussion today, included:

- Broadband
- Total Federal and State dollars received to date (breakdown both sources).
- Total projects completed with total costs to complete (list projects).
- New projects with projected start dates and costs (list projects).
- Total number of new and existing subscribers for each project completed.
- Update on State Park Internet Service upgrades. DHHR
- Status of consultant work to explore separation of DHHR into two separate departments

(Dept. of Health; Dept. of Human Resources.

- Also, what departments and divisions will fall within each agency, if applicable.
- More detailed update on Medicaid Title XIX waiver program, including monthly trends and any noted staffing shortages.
- Barriers to sufficient staffing to serve the needs of our aged and disabled citizens.
- Budget
- Breakdown of funded positions available in all departments and division, including a detailed list of unfilled vacancies; how long unfilled.
- Updates on loans made to new or existing businesses from the Industrial Development Loan Fund.

Roads and Infrastructure

- Update on "Roads to Prosperity" with all projects completed and costs.

New projects with anticipated start dates.

- Detailed maintenance information from around the state.
- \$200 million revolving loan between DOT and State Treasurer, including a list of monies for road maintenance.
- Updates of infrastructure investments, including a geographic check to see if funds are being distributed across the state according to need.
- Breakdown of Economic Enhancement Grant funds to include matching grants for water, sewer, and stormwater.
- List all projects and total appropriation of state dollars, along with county, municipal, and federal dollars involved in each project.

The above list is only a portion of what we expect to receive in future monthly reports. To their credit, some agencies provide reports monthly that could easily be on a quarterly basis or twice annually. This is a work in progress that the Joint Committee on Government and Finance is undertaking to make a positive difference - to make the state agencies more accountable and for the Legislature to act proactively to solve problems and issues. Otherwise, only reacting when there is a problem or issue wastes time and precious tax dollars.

Just One Generation cat rescue was started in 2013 in response to the severe feline overpopulation in this area. Our initial emphasis was on the Trap, Neuter, and Release (TNR) of feral cats as well as to facilitate the spay/neuter of domestic cats.

Adoption of ownerless cats and kittens came later, as was incorporated with the program because there was no place else for these animals to go.

But, due to previously made travel plans and family commitments, Just One Generation will not be available to take in new animals or to adopt cats and kittens during the months of June, July, and August 2022.

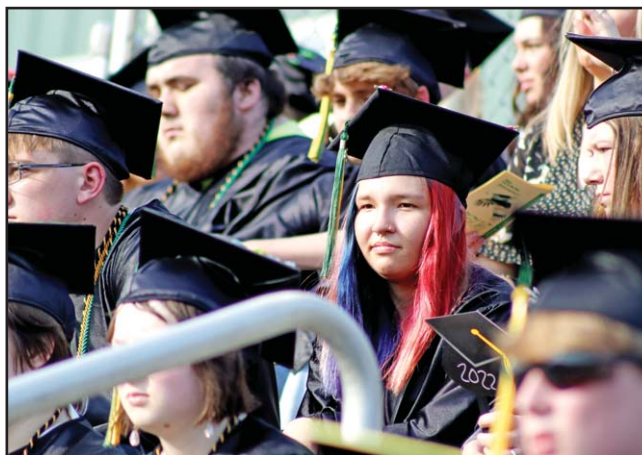
Valedictorian Ellen Collins talked about success to fellow students. She spoke of her passion for livestock and her success with her pigs.
